Iron knife, composed of a wooden handle (some fragments are still preserved) attached to the metal by means of two clamps from the archaeological site of Cerro de las Cabezas, Valdepeñas, Castilla-La Mancha, Spain. Iron Age (5th-3rd centuries BC). In the collection of the Valdepeñas Museum. Catalog number 211-CC00-U4B6-1. Model created in RealityCapture from 539 images. Additional processing in Geomagic Wrap and ZBrush.
