Lead staple commonly used to sew damaged pottery from the archaeological site of Cerro de las Cabezas, Valdepeñas, Castilla-La Mancha, Spain. Iron Age (5th-3rd centuries BC). In the collection of the Valdepeñas Museum. Catalog number 255-CC99-U53-4. Model created in RealityCapture from 429 images. Additional processing in Geomagic Wrap and ZBrush.
