



## Description

&#8220;The arched niche (arcosolium) for 2 burials is located in a corridor of the in the upper level of the Catacombs of San Gennaro (Naples). The Catacombs itself were used for burials from the 2nd century AD to the middle ages.

The paintings are in poor conservation status: A red-yellow frame system divides the surface in geometrical motives, in which different objects are placed. Today, only red flowers and heterogeneous dark structures are still identifiable.&#8221;

Processed from 184 photos and 2 laser scans in RealityCapture software. Additional processing was completed in Geomagic Wrap, InstantMeshes, and Blender. The result of a joint project of GDH, the Zamani Project, Università degli Studi di Napoli "L'Orientale", and the Administration of the Catacombe di Napoli. Processed in Reality Capture.
