Portrait of the emperor Lucius Verus from the site of Tarraco (Tarragona, Spain), dated in the 2nd century AD. Portrait of the emperor Lucius Verus, probably made by a local workshop in Luni-Carrara marble, following the prototype defined by an official sculptor in Rome. Found during the excavations of the so-called 'Cartanya well'; in the area of influence of the Tarraco Colonial Forum.
