



## Description

Gold pendant from the site of Castellet de Banyoles (Tarragona, Spain), dated between the 5th and 3th centuries BC. Found inside a pottery receptacle with bone and ash remains in the Iberian Oppidum of Castellet de Banyoles in Tivissa (Riviera d'Ebre). They would have been part of an ornamental object of which six pieces have been preserved.
