Small jug without decoration from Calatrava la Vieja, Castilla-La Mancha, Spain. Christian period, mid-13th century. This artifact was found in the 2009 excavations in the south-east sector of the medina, next to the western wall of the alcázar. Probably used as tableware for drinking or for containing liquids. Catalog No. CV 09 26 880 25. Processed and modeled in Reality Capture from 141 photos.
