



Description

The Turner River Site Complex is a very large prehistoric shellworks site located near Chokoloskee Island, in the Ten Thousand Islands area of southwest Florida. Dating to A.D.500-900 (Glades I-IIa), this site exhibits a complex arrangement of approximately 30 mounds and other architectural features constructed of shell and earth. The Turner River site is listed on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places.

This model was created from the 2007 Southwest Florida Water Management District aerial LiDAR data downloaded from the NOAA Data Access Viewer. These data were processed in Cloudcompare, Geomagic Wrap 2017, and Meshlab
