



Description

Cruggleton Church was established in the early 12th century by Fergus, Lord of Galloway. It is the best preserved and most complete Romanesque church in the region. The church was restored from a ruined condition in the 1890s by the 3rd Marquess of Bute.

Galloway Digital Heritage Project. The model was created in Reality Capture from 62 Leica RTC360 laser scans and 2564 images. Additional processing in Meshlab.
