There are petroglyphs on three sides of this rock. At least one appears to be an Ibex. Still under study.

Al Mudaifi is an archaeological site on a small hill on the north end of the town of Khor Fakkan on the east coast of Sharjah, UAE. It consists of a large number of petroglyphs that span the periods from the Neolithic to the 19th century.
